STUDENT PARENT ORIENTATION FOR 2018—2019 7TH GRADE

6TH grade parents are welcome to join us for this event on Thursday, May 3rd from 6:00 pm—7:00 pm. Bring your incoming seventh grader and enjoy a night designed to help future 7th grade students and parents make a successful transition to middle school.

STUDENT EARLY RELEASE:

Students leaving early during the school day need to have a note signed by the parent or legal guardian stating the time of pick-up and the person signing the student out. This note needs to be given to the teacher in the morning on the day of the early release. By sending a note, the teacher has a heads up, and it allows for the student to be prepared for early pick-up. **For security reasons, please do not ask that your child be called out of the classroom prior to your arrival and signing them out. Remember, photo ID will be required when signing a student out during the school day.** Plan on arriving in time to meet your appointment needs and the school's procedure for early releases. We appreciate everyone's cooperation in helping to keep our CIA students and staff safe.



REMINDER:

Students are not allowed to transport any meds to and from school. Therefore, parents will need to pick up any medications from our clinic before the last day of school, June 4th. Any prescription and/or over the counter medications left after the last day will be discarded.



If your student is out due to an illness, please call the absence line by 7am @317-869-1327 and follow the prompts. An absence for 3 or more days will require a doctor's note upon their return to be excused.

GUEST TEACHERS AND BUS DRIVERS NEEDED...

Warren Township schools are looking for classroom guest teachers for the 2017-18 school year. Classroom guest teachers, also referred to as substitute teachers, work a 7 1/2 hour day with a 30 minute lunch and a teacher prep period if assigned a classroom. Classroom guest teachers are paid \$80 a day and are eligible for a \$100 bonus after completing twenty classroom assignments. With 18 schools, and over 600 classrooms in the district, there are ample opportunities for being assigned to a class-room on a daily basis. REGISTRATION INFORMATION

2018-19

First Day of School: Monday July 30th

ALL new and returning K-8 students are REQUIRED to register at the school they will be attending.

What to bring with you to registration:

Students NEW to Warren Schools:

- *Textbook rental payment (cash, check, or charge)
- *Immunization records
- *Birth certificate (with official seal)
- * Parent/Guardian Photo ID
- *Records from former school (e.g. report card, high school transcript, withdrawal verification)
- *Custody documents if applicable
- *2 proofs of residency one from category A and one from Category B or C.
 - A: Current Gas or Electric Bill
 - B. If You Own: Closing documents, Warranty Deed, Current Monthly Mortgage Payment Statement, Quit Claim Deed, Current Year Tax Bill, Homestead Property Claim, Lease to Buy Contract, or Purchase Agreement. Driver's license or mortgage coupon books are NOT acceptable proofs of residency.
 - C: If you rent: Current Valid Lease

Students RETURNING to Warren Schools:

- *Textbook rental payment (cash, check, or charge) (WCHS students will receive textbook rental information in the mail in September)
- *Additional immunization records
- *If you have moved, 2 proofs of residency one from Category A and one from Category B or C:**
 - A: Current Gas or Electric Bill
 - B. If You Own: Closing documents, Warranty Deed, Current Monthly Mortgage Payment Statement, Quit Claim Deed, Current Year Tax Bill, Homestead Property Claim, Lease to Buy Contract, or Purchase Agreement. Driver's license or mortgage coupon books are NOT acceptable proofs of residency.
 - C: If you rent: Current Valid Lease

At the time of registration, **K-8** students will receive: Classroom assignments or schedules, supply lists, & lunch application forms.

Students currently residing outside of the MSD Warren Township boundary should contact the Warren Education & Community Center at 869-4300 for application information.
 Non-legal settlement applications will only be accepted June 1 – June 30, 2018
