A Word About Head Lice

This can happen to anyone, it's not uncommon. Most head lice are transmitted from head to head contact. Check your children regularly. If head lice are found consult a health care provider regarding treatment options. Follow package directions and comb out lice and nits thoroughly. While this is a time consuming task, it is also very effective at preventing repeat cycles. Clean all items that may have been in contact with your child's head. (combs, brushes, linens, stuffed animals, coats, etc) Let your children's close friends and family know so they can check regularly as well. Report all cases to the school nurse.
