Avoid the Top 10 Scams of 2020

Last year, as millions of Americans struggled to make ends meet due to the COVID-19 pandemic, scammers took advantage of an unprecedented opportunity to defraud consumers.

The combination of widespread economic vulnerability and social isolation brought on by the pandemic correlated with an increase in two specific fraud categories: bogus prize/sweepstakes/gift scams, and romance scams.

TOP TEN SCAMS OF 2020

- 1. Internet: Gen Merchandise
- 2. Phishing/Spoofing
- 3. Fake Check Scams
- 4. Friendship & Sweetheart Swindles
- 5. Prizes/Sweepstakes/Free Gifts
- 6. Advance Fee Loans, Credit Arrangers
- 7. Computers: Equipment/Software
- 8. Internet: Auctions
- 9. Investments: Other
- 10. Internet: Extortion



While the red flags of these scams vary from case to case, a good rule of thumb for recognizing these crimes is that a request for money to be sent to someone you have never met in person is almost a hallmark of a scam. Also, being aware that scammers are adept at creating a sense of urgency in their victims ("Pay now or you'll miss out on this prize!") is a good way to recognize some of these scams for what they are.

Please be cautious as you receive phone calls, emails, texts or items in the mailbox that want you to send money. *IT MAY BE A SCAM!*
