

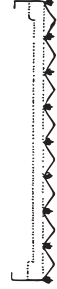
IMPORTANT!!!

BREAKING THE BUCKRAM

The buckram is the stiffener that is folded and sewn into the top of a Pleated Drapery. The buckram must be creased between each pleat for the drapery to traverse on the rod. **Caution:** Always wash and dry hands before breaking the buckram to avoid soiling the drapery heading.

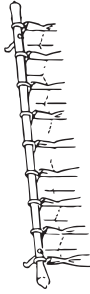
Conventional Traverse Rod -

The crease will fold FORWARD between the pleats when installing the drapery on a conventional traverse rod.



Decorative Traverse Rod -

The crease will fold BACKWARD behind the pleats when installing the drapery on a decorative traverse rod.

Installation:

- Your soft window fashions may have wrinkles because of the products shipping and handling. Do not be concerned. Your installer will dress out the majority, and most of the remaining wrinkles will hang out in about a week.

Care and Cleaning:
