of reported injuries were with horizontal blinds - the biggest culprit AND most common product in homes.

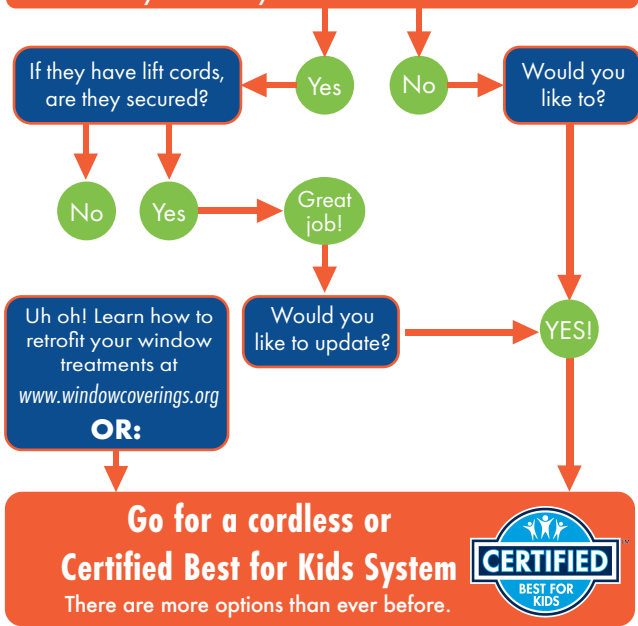

Check the windows at the places your child visits and plays often:



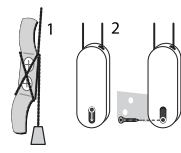
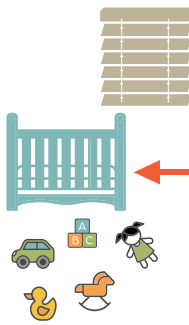
DAYCARE or school
