Raymond Park Parents and Guardians,

The purpose of this letter is to provide a Raymond Park mechanical system update and notify of accommodations that are being made for student comfort.

### Air Conditioning

Raymond Park's air conditioning system is in the process of being replaced. When the weather gets warm this spring, there will be some afternoons of warm temperatures in the school. To accommodate for warm afternoons, the middle school and intermediate academy are making the following student allowances for the remainder of this school year:

1. Students may wear school appropriate t-shirts on any day of the week (formerly, only spirit T-shirts on designated days).
2. Students may carry water bottles with them during the school day, being mindful that bottles should contain water only.

The plan of air conditioning replacement was purposefully timed to occur between seasons as neither the heating or cooling functions will operate during replacement. The new system will be both more proficient and reliable. In the meantime, air handlers are continuing to circulate air, and the district is providing fans to further help keep the air moving.

### Water Service

A water pipe burst after school on Friday causing water to be shut off in the building Friday afternoon. The pipe was fixed over the weekend, but some residual cloudiness remained in a few of the drinking fountains this morning. Shortly thereafter, the cloudiness washed through the system, and the water was checked to ensure drinking safety.

The Raymond Park staff continues to have your students' safety and comfort at the forefront of our considerations. Thank you for supporting good choices with dress accommodations and helping us keep the focus on academics during the final three weeks of school.
