Speaking directly to the student perspective, the return to the routines and structure of middle school from a summer of relaxation and fun can be a difficult transition for adolescents to make. I encourage you to take the time to talk with your student about how that transition will serve to facilitate your student's successful return to the learning environment. I also encourage you to change your routines at home to include an earlier bedtime and a designated place and time for study following the school day.


A copy of the 2017-2018 Standardized Wear Policy has been posted on the website for your review. I ask that you reinforce with your student that dress code compliance is expected on the first day of school.

Please make note of the following information and important dates related to the beginning of the school year:

- All students will be served breakfast daily in their first period class.
- The middle school is comprised of students in grades 7 and 8 and is located on the bottom level of the building. The intermediate academy is comprised of students in grades 5 and 6 and is located predominantly on the upper level of the building. To avoid the potential confusion of having RPMS and RPIA located in the same building, parents must be mindful that the two schools have separate offices. The RPMS office is located inside Entrance 1 and the school phone number is (317) 532-8900.
- **The first day of school** is Monday, July 31. RPMS wants parents to get involved, but parents are asked to allow the student to begin the middle school journey on his/her own.
- During the first week of school, your student will receive a great deal of information. Please review the information with your student to insure their understanding of the requirements for success at RPMS.
- **Back-to-School Night** is scheduled to occur 6:00-7:00 PM on Thursday, August 10. Parents will have the opportunity to meet teachers, learn of expectations and tour the school.
- **Please join the PTSA (Parent, Teacher, Student Association).** Parent participation in his/her child's school has a direct correlation to the child's school success. PTSA dues are \$7.00 and may be paid at Back-to-School Night.
- The **all-school fundraiser** is scheduled to kick-off on Thursday, August 10. Proceeds from the fundraiser are used to support and reward RPMS students. Thank you in advance for your participation in this event.
- **School pictures** will be taken during the school day on Wednesday, August 16.
- The school nurse does administer over-the-counter medications in the clinic for student use (Tylenol, ibuprofen, cough drops, etc.). Parents that desire to have over-the-counter medication available for their student must bring the medication to school in an original bottle that will be kept in the clinic, and complete a consent form.
