ISTEP is approaching! Here are some tips from your school counselor to keep your student's brain and body ready to go!

1. SLEEP: A brain that is rested is a brain that remembers
2. GOOD BREAKFAST: giving your body a good breakfast to start the day can give energy and can even help your mood
3. COPING SKILLS: With your students go over some ways they can calm themselves down if they get frustrated during the test. Some examples include:
  - a. taking deep breaths
  - b. counting to 10 and back down to 1
  - c. mentally remind themselves that it is important that they try their best but if they don't know something, that is OK!
4. Lastly, I encourage you to start everyday with something called a mantra: a word or phrase that is meant to bring positive energy to your student! For example, have your student say each morning: "I am great, I will make good choices, I love myself!"
