Dear Eastridge Families: Do you know your child needs time and space to think critically? Critical thinking -the ability to go beyond basic knowledge and consider "the bigger picture" -is a crucial skill for school success. The better the students are able to think critically, the more deeply they will grasp new concepts and ideas. To promote these skills: Let your child figure things out. Resist the urge to solve every problem. Instead, give him/her time to work through problems himself/herself. Ask questions like- "How can you figure this out?" and "I can see how you feel about this. But why do you think other people might feel differently?"

Next Monday and Tuesday all third graders will be taking the state mandatory IREAD 3 assessment. This assessment is a summative assessment based on Indiana Academic Reading Standards from Kindergarten to third grade. Our testing will begin promptly at 10:30 on both days. Please make sure your student is present on both days. This test is only given March 12th - March 16. If your child misses the test they will have to attend summer school.

Finally, Spring Break is fast approaching! We are on Spring Break the weeks of March 19th and March 26th. It is important that your child is at school everyday leading up to break. Teachers are working hard to finish up assessments in preparation of report cards which will be sent home on Friday, March 16th.

As always, enjoy your weekend and thank you for trusting Eastridge Elementary to educate your child.

When/Where: April 9th, 2018 from 5:30-7pm at Eastridge Elementary.

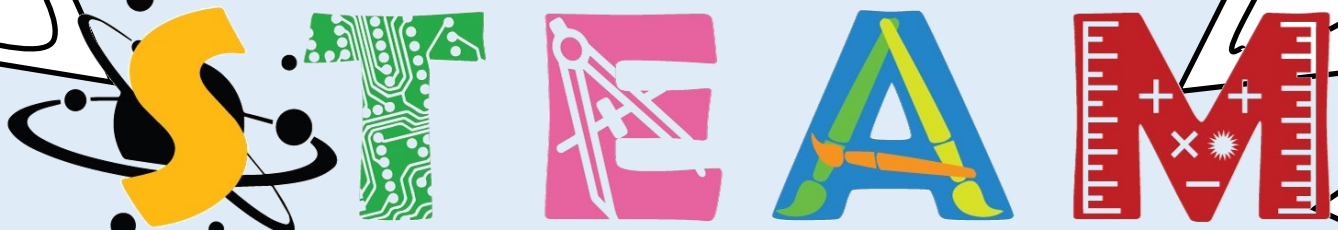
