COUNSELOR'S CORNER

It has been busy this week in your school counselors office! I have been working with students on a number of things, for example:

Did you know that in terms of high stress, your brain actually has a hard time processing thoughts, and can even affect your memory? I am working on a series of grade appropriate lessons that will help students learn about how their own brain functions in relation to behavior. For example, if you are so angry that you are yelling, throwing things, refusing to listen, etc..., it could likely be that your brain has gone into total emotional take-over. It is important to allow students the space to calm down so that the thinking/processing/problem solving part of their brain turns back on.

Expressing feelings in a healthy way through writing and poetry:

Anger.. It's like a volcano! You have control over it until it erupts...after that, the consequences that follow are out of your control. DON'T LET YOURSELF ERUPT! Use coping skills, like breathing, taking a break, listen to music, lying down, and many more to keep yourself from exploding.

Practice saying kind words to each other. However it is ALWAYS important to lift your peers up with words of encouragement and not judgement or meanness.

Tip for parents: talk with your student about choosing battles. Many times I observe students getting angered simply because someone is "looking at me." I am working on some lessons/activities that encourage students to "choose your narrative." If someone is looking at you, tell yourself that maybe they are looking at someone else or perhaps they are having a bad day and are taking it out by flashing a mean look. It is IMPOSSIBLE to prove that someone was looking at you, therefore it is hard to catch or problem solve in the classroom.
