




## PRINCIPAL'S POINT:

Good evening families,  
We will be finishing on Monday with ISTEP testing for the 2017-2018 school year, and we appreciate your support throughout the process. As we enter the month of May, please consider reaching out to your child's teacher to see what types of things your child can work on over the summer months. The research shows that students who do not participate in any academic tasks (read a book daily, practice math skills, write, etc.) over the summer, lose almost half of a school year's worth of learning, which is called summer learning loss. On the other hand, those that do, are proven to gain between 2 and 3 months of learning. That ends up being a difference of almost 3/4 of a school year when comparing the groups of students. Our staff would be happy to give you ideas and resources for your child to work on during the months of June and July.
