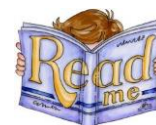
ROBOTICS TEAMS RETURN FROM WORLD COMPETITION!

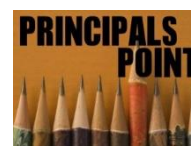
PRINCIPAL'S POINT:

Good evening families,

As we enter the month of May, please consider reaching out to your child's teacher to see what types of things your child can work on over the summer months. The research shows that students who do not participate in any academic tasks (read a book daily, practice math skills, write, etc.) over the summer, lose almost half of a school year's worth of learning, which is called summer learning loss. On the other hand, those that do are proven to gain between 2 and 3 months of learning. That ends up being a difference of almost 3/4 of a school year when comparing the groups of students. Our staff would be happy to give you ideas and resources for your child to work on during the months of June and July.

CYSTIC FIBROSIS AWARENESS!



Cystic fibrosis is an inherited disorder that causes severe damage to the lungs, digestive system and other organs in the body. It is lifelong and fatal disease. Cystic fibrosis affects the cells that produce mucus, sweat and digestive juices. These secreted fluids are normally thin and slippery. In people with cystic fibrosis, a defective gene causes the secretions to become sticky and thick. Instead of acting as a lubricant, the secretions plug up tubes, ducts and passageways, especially in the lungs and pancreas. You can help by spreading awareness throughout your community by wearing purple in honor of Caleb and Kaden which are identical twins that are 7 and attend Grassy Creek and you can donate to the cystic fibrosis foundation or you can leave anything at the office with their name on it and it can be given to them. They are amazing boys and they have been through so much already in their little lives that most of us never endure in a whole lifetime. Their life expectancy is around their 20s or so with the mutations they have as long as their little lungs last that long. But they don't let cystic fibrosis stop them or define them in any way. We are trying to give them the best life we can and let them experience as much as we can because we never know when it will be their last one. So anything is greatly appreciated. 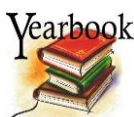
