June 16 *For Greater Glory* is a true story about the Cristero War in Mexico at the beginning of the 20th Century. A retired military man leads the resistance in this historical account of faithfulness to the point of surrendering one's life for the freedom to worship God.

June 23 *Paul, Apostle of Christ* is an inspiring account about St. Paul, St. Luke and the early Christians in Nero's Rome in 64 A.D. Despite the military strength of pagan Rome, the movie illustrates how authentic faith can effectively challenge any secular empire that opposes Christ.

June 30 *Fatima* is the 2020 movie about the multiple visitations of Our Lady of the Rosary to three young Portuguese children in 1917. The children share with the people of their time the Blessed Mother's message that only through prayer and suffering would WWI end. The movie reveals the price the young visionaries paid as they obediently conveyed the messages of the Blessed Mother during a time of disbelief and rebellion. The message of Fatima goes beyond the turn of the 20th century and is also meant for our modern times.

July 7 *The Passion of Bernadette* tells the story about how a simple girl who had visions of the Blessed Mother lived out her life as Sister Marie Bernard in the convent of the Sisters of Nevers in the late 19th century. What the movie shows is that Bernadette became a saint through a life of prayer, faith, suffering a deep love for her sisters in community. After her death in 1879 at the age of 35, her exhumed body was found to be incorrupt.

July 14 *Joseph of Nazareth* is a movie about an ordinary carpenter chosen by God to marry and protect the Blessed Mother and serve as a father to the Messiah. Throughout the movie, we see how St. Joseph had to grapple with the mysteries of divine conception, virgin birth and the Incarnation of the Son of God. His obedience to God and his love of Mary and the Child Jesus teach us what faithfulness looks like despite hardships and challenges in life.
