One of my favorite songs the children learn while participating in Catechesis of the Good Shepherd teaches them why priests wear certain colors throughout the liturgical year...

"Purple and Green and Red and White, are the colors of the year.
Purple and Green and Red and White remind us of the light.
Purple is for preparation,
White is for celebration.
Green is for the growing time,
Red is for the Pentecost."

"Purple is for preparation..", the color we will see in our Church as we begin our season of Lent. Lent is a time we make sacrifices, participate in almsgiving and prayer to replicate the sacrifices Jesus Christ made during His 40 days in the desert.

One teacher at our school prays the Rosary with her children every night during Lent. I asked if her young children were able to sit still the entire time and she responded, "I don't expect them to completely participate. It's more for them to hear us pray to God and guide them to do the same when they are able." Children are always watching and imitating and I can't think of a better activity to imitate other than prayer. We pray you have a prayerful Lenten Season.
