Fr. Ignatius (Zig) Mazanowski is a graduate of St. Luke Catholic School and Bishop Chatard High School in Indianapolis, Indiana. He earned his sacred theology doctorate in moral theology from Santa Croce in Rome. He wrote his dissertation on Mercy, Forgiveness and Healing of the Heart. He has led retreats and has given talks nationally and internationally to priests, religious sisters and lay people on this topic and he recently published his book *Healing of the Heart Journal*.
