Students who have been attending the SERV lunches are especially invited to join us for the Ordination of Deacon Timothy Decrane and Vinny Gillmore.

The Ordination Mass is special and should be experienced at least once. Participate in the very important moment for the person being ordained, giving him new responsibilities in the Catholic Church. Witness the calling forth of the candidates, their promises to diligently perform the duties of the Priesthood and respect and obey the bishop. Pray as they lie prostrate before the altar, invoking all of the saints for prayer and blessings by singing the Litany of the Saints.

One of the most crucial parts of the Ordination Mass is when the bishop silently lays his hands on each candidate before offering the consecratory prayer, summoning the Holy Spirit upon them. Experience the beauty of the vestment of the stole and chasuble, and the bishop anointing the new priests's hands with chrism before presenting the holy chalice and paten whet the priest will use when presiding at the Eucharist.
