Presidents Remarks:

Mandy has met with Mrs. Burns to discuss her needs and vision for the parish library/ resource room. On Thursday, the two will meet with RJE Business Interiors for information on how they may be able to help. She will follow-up with PTO, but the meeting's purpose is purely informational at this time.

Wednesday, 9/21 is the first spirit day of the year. Mandy will meet with the teachers and discuss their available funds and how PTO grants work.

Grant request: Submitted by Mrs. Laux for \$497.50 was passed by the PTO board. Mrs. Laux will use money for 8th grade art display that in part, will be used year after year.

This year's focus of STEM has been asked by Mrs Borland to include Religion and Art and will have a STREAM focus. More to come on school activities to incorporate.

PTO has been asked to participate in funding of the new playground. No dollar amount has been requested, so more to come in the future. Angela Agricola gave information regarding the playground committee and where it sits. Funds from last year and this year's Fall Fest will be directed to the new playground. It is unclear if there will be amounts available for a safer ground floor. PTO members recommended various ways to raise any additional money to complete the project including sponsorships and paddle auctions at Trivia night.

Treasurers Report:

PTO dues are up compared to total dues paid last year. 250 families have paid this year.

Ashley is working to increase certain committee budgets that need more money allocated and adding a STREAM line item. Ashley has also been working closely with fundraising this last month regarding trash bags.

Faculty Report provided by Kate Bruner:

Update regarding 8th grades record garage sale: \$640 of each student's Washington, DC trip will be subtracted from their total based on sale. Wow!

The Technology and Tech Strategy Plan is being redeveloped to include: WIFI update, budgeting for Tech replacement funds each year and expansion of IPADs for all incoming 8th graders in 2017-18 year and also allowing for additional IPADs for new students or transfers within the 5th-8th grade years.

Currently NWEA test being conducted in grades K-8. NWEA replaces previous AIMES test. NWEA is similar to AIMES in that it looks for growth, but different because tests are taken online, and more in-depth testing allows for teachers to get better understanding of what each student understands and knows. The data is almost immediately available to the teacher and students will have specific goals created for them that can be shared as the student changes grades each year, ultimately helping teachers and students. NWEA testing will be done in the fall, January and spring to measure student's progress throughout the year.

Singapore Math informational parent session occurring 9/21 at 6:30pm. Singapore Math was adopted this year but the School Board for grades K-3.

Regarding STREAM focus this year, a Family Math Night is being planned for next January.

Committee Reports:

Arts & Enrichment:

Classes began this past Monday, 9/19 with over 300 kids enrolled in After School Enrichment (ASE). Next semester of ASE will begin in January.

STREAM meeting next week with Heather Allen. Mrs Kelly will meet and report teachers ideas and needs from PTO. Treasurer will also meet with Heather to discuss budget.

Fundraising:

Trash bag sales were up \$2600 over last year. If we sell all the extras purchased, PTO to make \$40,000 this year.

Yovonne Grego updated class thermometers last week announcing class contest winners. Class contests did not include late orders and donations. Class contest party dates will be planned this week and communicated to students. Dates will be set and not subject to change based on any individual's ability or not to participate on that date. Waivers will be required for some and will be distributed thru the classrooms.

Trash bag delivery is Wednesday, Sept 21 from 1:00 - 5:30 and Thursday, Sept 22 from 7:30 - 9:30 and 2:30 - 6:00. If you have wagons available to load, please drop them off with your name on it. Volunteers are still needed.
