



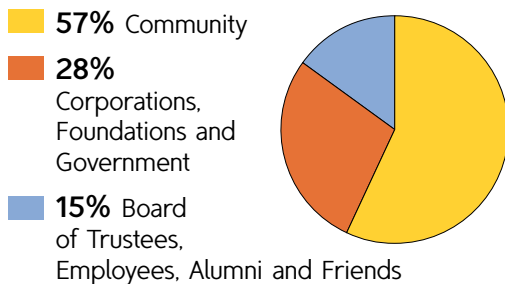
Mission Statement
