Credit Recovery/Tutoring



Academic Growth and Recovery (AGR) Program is an educational related resource that works in collaboration with educators, mental health specialist, and other community agencies to design customized programs and interventions for students and families in the Warren community. AGR aims to raise the graduation rate and decrease the number of absences, suspensions and drop outs in the Metropolitan School District of Warren Township. AGR offers remediation and assistance in the areas of English, Math, and Science. AGR also offers assistance in the area of credit recovery to give students extra assistance. Mental health advocates, school safety officers and a plethora community support systems will be available to offer guidance.

School Safety



Topics will include: social media, anti-bullying, human trafficking, and decision making

Truancy Intervention



The Truancy Intervention Program is designed to help students understand the consequences of their behavior and help them make better choices about their future. Credit recovery will be monitored.

Anger Management



Topics will include: identification of triggers, conflict mediation, problem solving, and collaboration with others

Community Service



The Community Service Program is an alternative to suspension for excessive absences. Students actively participate in community programs such as Habitat for Humanity, etc.
