# **Parent Volunteers**

Any parent or guardian who would like to volunteer at school or chaperone a field trip must have a Criminal Background Check completed

(copy of driver's license must be included). Forms are available in the school office. Please allow *at least* two weeks for the paperwork to be processed. No one will be allowed to volunteer or chaperone a field trip without this paperwork on file.

\*\*If you completed a Background Check last year, please check with the school office to see if you need to complete a new one for this year.

### FROM THE DEAN:

Children will only be released early if they have proof of a medical appointment. Documentation may be provided in the form of an appointment notice or reminder card. If one is not available, then a doctor's excuse will need to be presented upon the student's return. Failure to provide adequate documentation will result in an unexcused absence and will fall under state truancy protocol. Also, students are tardy after the bell rings at 8:40 a.m.



**Free & Reduced Form:** Free & Reduced (Assistance) forms need to be completed each year. If you have not filled out a new form for the 18/19 school year, please do so or you will be returned to full pay. Forms are available in the school office.

**Volunteers:** If you would like to volunteer in any Warren Township school, you need to complete a Criminal History Background Check form



nal History Background Check form and provide a copy of your driver's license or state I.D. You will need to allow approximately 2 weeks for the Background Check to be processed.

**Phone Numbers:** Please be sure to notify the school of any changes in home, cell or emergency phone numbers. This is very important in case of an emergency or illness.

### **Medication**

All medications must be brought to school by a parent or guardian. DO NOT send medications with your child

on the bus. There is a form that MUST be filled out by the parent in order for school personnel to dispense medications. The medicine must be in the original prescription bottle. If you have any questions, contact the school nurse at 532-3807.
