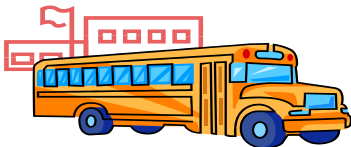

Bus Conduct & Safety Rules

Bus conduct and safety rules are designed to promote safety on the buses at all times because the safety of all students is our top priority. ***School bus transportation is a privilege.***

If transportation privileges are denied, parents or guardians are responsible for getting the child to and from school. To promote a safe, orderly, efficient and enjoyable bus ride to and from school, all students must follow the rules listed in the **Student Rights and Responsibilities Handbook** each family received at the start of the school year.



Reminders:

Free & Reduced Form: Free & Reduced (Assistance) forms need to be completed each year. If you have not filled out a new form for the 17/18 school year, please do so by 9/5/17 or you will be returned to full pay. Forms are available in the school office.



Volunteers: If you would like to volunteer in any Warren Township school, you need to complete a Criminal History Background Check form and provide a copy of your driver's license or state I.D. You will need to allow approximately 2 weeks for the Background Check to be processed.

Phone Numbers: Please be sure to notify the school of any changes in home, cell or emergency phone numbers. This is very important in case of an emergency or illness.

Parent Volunteers

Any parent or guardian who would like to volunteer at school or chaperone a field trip must have a Criminal Background Check completed (copy of driver's license must be included). Forms are available in the school office. Please allow *at least* two weeks for the paperwork to be processed. No one will be allowed to volunteer or chaperone a field trip without this paperwork on file.

*****If you completed a Background Check last year, please check with the school office to see if you need to complete a new one for this year.***
