IT'S SUPER READER TIME!

Hawthorne Media Center sponsors the Super Reader Program each school year. The purpose of the program is to encourage children to read for fun and to provide the parents with an opportunity to support that success. There are many sources of books available for students to read: school library, public library, classroom library, e-books, and their own home library that can be added to by purchasing books from our book fairs. All students may earn prizes for each reading goal they meet with the final goal being a Super Reader!

Super reader guidelines:

- ◆ Students should be reading at or above their reading level. Younger students can be read to and list those books on their reading log.
- ◆ After reading a book, the students will list those books on a reading log (kindergarten-2nd) or a book report form (3rd & 4th) and have it signed by a parent or guardian.
- ◆ Students will turn in their reading logs or book report forms to their teachers for approval.
- ◆ Teachers and the Media Center will keep a record for each student, and prizes will be given out as they reach a reading goal.

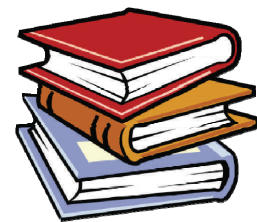
