

Hello Lakeside Parents and Guardians,

If your child is in 3rd or 4th grade, please note that ISTEP+ testing begins the week of February 26. We ask that you attempt to refrain from scheduling appointments, especially during morning hours, during that week.

Our 3rd graders will begin IREAD-3 testing on Monday, March 12. It is absolutely critical for 3rd graders to be present for each session of the IREAD-3 test on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday of that week. There are no make-ups after Friday, March 16. If a student misses all or any portion of the test by the end of that week, they will automatically have to attend the IREAD-3 summer session and take the assessment again.

I am very proud of our staff and students for the great teaching and learning that takes place at Lakeside every day! I am confident our students will be ready to do well on these high-stakes assessments ahead. Thanks for your continued support with having your children at school on time each day and ready to learn!

Welcome to the Counselor's Corner!



- **This Week:** As Valentine's Day approaches, here in the counselor's office we are working on how our words affect others. A recent lesson I did talks about the importance of using kind words. Often times I notice students *"joking" with each other, but can quickly escalate to something very hurtful. KNOW THE IMPACT of your words! Try practicing the simple task of giving a compliment...tell someone in your household that you like their shoes or outfit!*
- **Parents:** Ask your child this week, **"what have you done to show kindness to someone?"** Have your child say it outloud, and let them know that is AWESOME!
- Remind your student to continue showing kindness to their teachers and peers...this is a HUGE part of showing RESPECT as a part of C.O.R.E. (Civility, Order, Respect, and Excellence)
