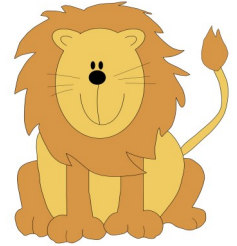

**Weekly Counselor News:**

- This week's attendance statistic: Absences within the first month can negatively impact a student's year long attendance! Make sure you're working to get your student here as much as possible!
- This month's lesson topic was how anger is like a volcano - talk to your student about how dino brain is like a volcano erupting and that consequences are like the lava that flows down the side - unstoppable!
- Pump your student up about things that are positive about school! Who are their friends - ask who they are are what they did together today - relationships both peer and adult are KEY to building success in school.



**SCHOOL DISTRICT PUBLICATIONS/ NEWS MEDIA USE FOR STUDENTS**
