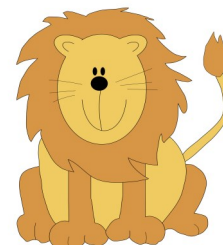

- Attendance Statistic of the Week: **By 6th grade, chronic absence becomes a leading indicator that a student will drop out of high school**
