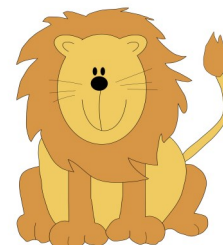

Students will not be released from vehicles or school buses before the 8:30 a.m. start time. Students must remain in their vehicle until a Lakeside staff member signals their release. **When a student arrives late, an adult needs to escort the child to the office (no drop offs)** and complete a late pass before going to class.

Parents, please call by 9:00 am each day to report an absence. Please leave the name and room number of your child, your name and the reason for the absence. Please send a note/doctor's note back to school with your child.

Physical Education Dress

Students need to wear athletic shoes and clothing comfortable for exercise on all physical education days. Lakeside uses a 4 day rotation for Unified Arts. Students will have PE on Red, White, Blue or Green day. Please learn and plan for your child's PE day.



The occasion may arise when the school district wants to recognize your child or your child's school. We may also want to tell the media (including newspapers, television and radio) about your child's achievements. We never knowingly release information about a student to anyone who wants to use it for commercial/political purposes. **School Dress Wear Policy**

Lakeside School has a Standardized Dress Wear Policy. Please check your child(ren) each morning for proper school dress. Students arriving at school out of uniform will call home for acceptable clothing. See our Lakeside handbook for additional information regarding this policy.

**Background Checks**

Do...

- Find a quiet spot to observe your student
- Schedule a meeting with your student's teacher if you would like to talk with them about an issue (they will probably be very busy teaching to stop and talk while you're observing)
- Check in on your student! We will call the student down to the office for you so you don't have to walk ALL the way down to their classroom.
- Leave any lunch boxes or materials that need to get to your student at the office. We will make sure they get to them!

Don't...

- Expect the teacher to be able to stop teaching to talk with you. We want them to focus on our kiddos!
- Take any pictures or record anything due to confidentiality regarding all students.
- Be surprised if the principal or designee sits in with you on your visit. They like to check in on the students and teachers as well.
- Forget to come back! We want you here to see all the neat things going on with your student.

Student Drop-off/Pick-up Procedures



We ask that our parents follow these guidelines to insure that every student has a safe arrival and dismissal:

In order to increase the safety of all of our students and adults entering and leaving the building each day, all students will be required to be dropped-off and picked-up through the car rider line. Parking at the front and East end of the building and walking children to and from the entrances will not be allowed. We would like to prevent children and adults walking through the path of cars or buses on the property at any time.

Staff members will be present outside beginning at 8:30 a.m. each morning for student drop-off. Please do not release your children until a staff member signals the beginning of our process. Students will not be counted tardy until 8:40 a.m. Our afternoon pick-up procedures will begin at 3:30 p.m. If you are in a hurry, you are encouraged to be at or near the front of the line and we will implement our dismissal procedures as quickly and safely as possible for all.
