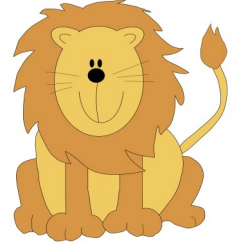

Dear Lakeside Parents and Guardians,

Yesterday, we sent a memo home with your child regarding our upcoming Super Parents Are the CORE Night on Thursday, August 31. If you are able to attend, please send the bottom half of the memo back with your child on Monday so that we can have an idea on how much pizza we need to make for the Lakeside children that will attend with you. Below, I have included the same information that was sent in the memo.

Super Parents Are the Core Night

On Thursday, August 31, we will be hosting our first Super Parents Are the Core Night at Lakeside. The evening will begin at 6:00 p.m. and will end no later than 7:45 p.m. During the event, you will have an opportunity to learn more about the following topics:

- Standards-based report cards
- Digital content utilized to support personalization
- Eureka Math
- CORE/PBIS
- NWEA

Members of our staff will repeat each session 3 times over the course of the evening. You will be asked to choose 3 of the 5 topics being offered. Each session will be 25 minutes in length with a brief transition time between sessions. In addition, during the event, we plan to offer pizza and a dance party for your children who currently attend Lakeside. If you are able to attend and if you are bringing one or more Lakeside students with you, please complete the bottom half of this paper, cut on the dotted line, and send the half-sheet back to school with your child. We want to make sure we have enough pizza for the Lakeside students who will be attending. Please note that we will not be able to feed or supervise children who are not currently Lakeside students. We will also not have the ability to feed adults either. We appreciate your understanding and look forward to seeing you at the event!

NWEA and ISTEP+ Data

On Friday, September 1, all parents should be receiving an NWEA student report that provides details for how your child performed on the first NWEA assessment of this school year. You are welcome to attend one of the NWEA sessions during our Super Parents Are the CORE night in order to gain a greater understanding of the information you will receive.

If your child is currently a 4th grader and took the ISTEP+ assessment at Lakeside last semester, you should also be receiving a student performance report on Friday, September 1.
