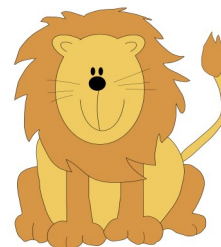

Parent-Teacher Conferences

Please remember that our annual Parent-Teacher conferences will be held on Tuesday, October 3, from 11:00 a.m.-7:00 p.m. It will be critical to schedule an appointment to ensure you have an opportunity to meet with your child's teacher. There will be no school for children on October 3.

Grandparent/Special Adult Breakfast

Lakeside Elementary School is excited to have our 8th annual Grandparent/Special Adult Breakfast on Thursday, October 5, 2017, from 7:20-8:05 a.m. in the school cafeteria. Parking will be available at the rear of the school building and door 4 in the back will be open for all to enter. We will kindly ask all adults to leave promptly after the breakfast to ensure we have parking space for our buses that will be arriving around 8:20 a.m. Also, due to limited space, we ask that each child attend with no more than 2 adults.

Car Riders

For safety purposes, our staff would greatly appreciate you adhering to our drop-off and pick-up procedures at all times. In the morning, we ask that all students be dropped-off along the curb in front of the main entrance. We will begin the drop-off procedure at 8:30 a.m., unless there is a late start time. No students should be released prior to a staff member signaling for drop-off to begin. Please do not park and walk students into the building unless you have an appointment or need to see our front office staff. In addition, please do not park at the end of the front sidewalk at the East end of the building and allow your child to walk down the sidewalk.

In the afternoon, we ask that you wait in the car rider line and pick-up at the curb. Please make sure you or another approved adult has a Lakeside issued card with your child's name on it to show to the staff member at the curb.

I sincerely appreciate your full attention to our drop-off and pick-up procedures. Safety for all is and always will be our first priority at Lakeside.
