PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES...

School will not be in session on Tuesday, October 2, 2018

due to conferences being held. Report cards for the first nineweek grading period will be given out at conferences. Your conference times will be scheduled by the child's teacher and will be coming home soon.



Weekly Counselor News:

- Current lesson of the month discusses with your student what consequences are. How they happen whether or not you apologize after negative behavior. This is a huge concept for students to grasp. Work with your child on preventing those behaviors that result in consequences by using their coping skills: such as deep breaths, talking it out, laying their head down, etc...
- Talk to your student about how consequences and dino brain work. If you make choices in dino brain you might have some negative consequences!
- Talk about consequences at home... and have some established consequences es so your child knows what behaviors are acceptable or not.



Birthday Treat Policy: Starting this 18/19 school year, all MSD Warren Schools will be aligning their birthday celebration policies to the district's wellness policy. As part of our
