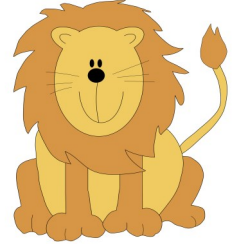

Welcome to the Counselor's Corner!



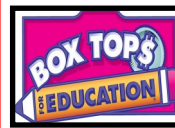
Here are some updates...Your student may have mentioned by Brainger lesson, which we have wrapped up this week! If you remember, this lesson taught students about their brains, how anger affects it, and how to gain control of it.

Here is some data! Data is based on the responses from 218 students that received the Brainger Lesson:

- 97% of students were able to identify that the dino brain is active when a person is angry.
 - 92% of students were able to identify that the front brain is active when a person makes good decisions, has conversations, and is able to think clearly!
 - 92% of students were able to correctly identify the hand signal that indicates they are in dino brain.
 - 87% of students were able to correctly identify the hand signal that indicates they are in front brain.
- I am super excited that YOUR students have taken such an interest in their own brains!

As the year draws closer to an end, I will be working with your students on transitions for the next year, what to expect, and how to prepare! Our Healing Hearts service has been very successful in helping your students cope with the loss of a loved one while still being successful in school...shout out to Community Health Network for this Awesome program! Also with respect to grief, if you are interested in summer bereavement support, Camp Erin is a weekend grief camp that students may apply to attend!
