****CAR RIDERS/DAYCARE*** Student Drop-off/Pick-up Procedures



We ask that our parents follow these \checkmark quidelines to insure that every student has a safe arrival and dismissal:

In order to increase the safety of all of our students and adults entering and leaving the building each day, all students will be required to be dropped-off and picked-up through the car rider line. Parking at the front and East end of the building and walking children to and from the entrances will not be allowed. We would like to prevent children and adults walking through the path of cars or buses on the property at any time.

Staff members will be present outside beginning at 8:30 a.m. each morning for student drop-off. Please do not release your children until a staff member signals the beginning of our process. Students will not be counted tardy until 8:40 a.m. Our afternoon pick-up procedures will begin at 3:30 p.m. If you are in a hurry, you are encouraged to be at or near the front of the line and we will implement our dismissal procedures as quickly and safely as possible for all.

We are off to a great start!! Already your students are getting to know or refreshed on what dino brain is, and how to control anger with coping skills of their choice. I have already reached to many of you about how to best support your student. Re-

member - I am here to support your student and you! We offer a different options for your child's mental health/counseling needs, and I can help navigate that! In the coming weeks I will be putting together an attendance club to work with students who seem to be missing school - We love our students and want them here as much as possible! Here are some talking points to discuss with your student:

- 1. How are you working to follow directions in class?
- 2. What is dino brain? How do you get back into front brain?
- 3. How can you show C.O.R.E. even when you're upset?
- 4. What startegies can you use to ignore people who may not be your friend, while still showing Respect?
- 5. Why do you come to school? Parents, use this as a chance to really talk with your kids about the importance of coming to schoolto learn and gain knowledge. It is important to make friends and enjoy it, but it is equally important to come to school focused and ready to learn!
