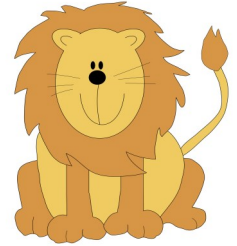

SCHOOL DISTRICT PUBLICATIONS/ NEWS MEDIA USE FOR STUDENTS



The occasion may arise when the school district wants to recognize your child or your child's school. We may also want to tell the media (including newspapers, television, and radio) about your child's achievements. We never knowingly release information about a student to anyone who wants to use it for commercial/political purposes. However, we will honor your request to not include your child in these types of recognitions if you notify your child's school office in writing that you do not want this type of information released.

- Weekly Attendance Statistic: Frequent absences from school can shape adulthood (DOE Study)
- Weekly Behavioral Statistic: in 2015 29.3% of Indiana students reported feeling sad and/or hopeless (CDC, 2015)
- College & Career: This month is National Career Development Month: encourage your child to talk about what they want to be when they grow up, schedule fun (and sometimes free) activities to go shadow a career that interests your student!
