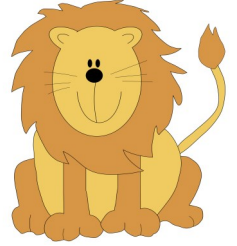

Welcome to the Counselor's Corner!

Conflict Resolution is happening A LOT in the counselor's office! How can you enforce this at home? With Summer approaching, many students are getting excited for break which unfortunately can mean disputes and peer conflict! It is super important to help your student know how to handle conflict appropriately! Steps that Mr. Phillips takes to walk students through Conflict Resolution:

1. Identify timeline: for example, at what point were you in your FRONT brain (able to talk and have conversations? Write this out...Be able to show with a pen where each step occurred
2. When did the first conflict happen?
 - A. When did you realize something was off..."after they said my shoes were ugly"
 - B. What did you say that could have been misinterpreted...We call this miscommunication...I said A but I meant B.
 - i. "Maybe I said their shoes were ugly but I was joking!"
 - ii. Should we joke about others shoes? NO! That can be hurtful!
3. Offer an apology for the miscommunication. Yes, I said your shoes were ugly, I was joking, and I am sorry...for what I said BUT ALSO how it made you feel. Letting someone know you are sorry for making them feel upset means you are resolving the negative emotion associated with the conflict, which I find is what sparks disputes between students!
 - Keep working on this throughout the end of the year and into the summer!
 - Mr. Phillips will also be putting together a list of local summer programs that I will be sending home in the next week or so! Be on the lookout!
 - As always, contact me if needed, just call the front office and ask for Mr. Phillips!)

Medication in the Clinic

If your student has any kind of medication in the school clinic, please be sure to pick this up by our last day of school, Monday, June 4th. In Warren Township, students grades K-8 are not allowed to transport medication on the school bus; therefore medication must be picked up by a parent or guardian, or someone designated by the parent or guardian over the age of 18 years old.



Any medication not picked up by the end of the school day on June 4th will be disposed of appropriately by our school nurse. We cannot keep medications in the clinic over the summer break.
