FAFSA is Changing—PPY Filing

The FAFSA filing process has changed. This year you will file your student's FAFSA with taxes from 2015 (Prior Prior Year or PPY). The benefit in this new process is that you should already have your taxes available when the window opens on **October 1st**.

The process of filling out the application should be much faster. You will be able to pull your tax information into the form easily and skip questions that do not apply to you.

The goal in making these changes is to increase the number of students applying for financial aid and potentially increase the college going rate.

You are also likely receive financial package information earlier and be able to make a more well informed decision about which college is the best fit. For more information visit:

FAQ's

Q: Can I graduate early?

A: Students that have fulfilled all CORE 40 diploma requirements and have passed both parts of the ECA by Decem ber 22nd are eligible to graduate at the semester.

Q. Can I go to night school?

A. Night school is not the right fit for everyone. Students attending night school need very few credits and have passed the ECA. If you think this is the right fit for you, please contact your counselor.

Q: How do I order senior packs and my cap and gown?

A: Herff Jones will be here beginning September 7th. Stop by the table at lunch to place your order. You can find more information at Herffjones.com

Q: Do I have to attend the Commencement ceremony?

A: No one is required to attend commencement, but it is a once in a lifetime experience that we encourage all students to attend.

Q: Can I have a half day schedule?

A: The state of Indiana requires that students attend school for at least 6 hours each day. While there are exceptions to that rule, there must be extenuating circumstances that require an altered schedule.

Q: Can I drop AP or Dual Credit classes at the semester?

A: The Course of Study Guide indicates which classes are full year courses. IF you are enrolled in a full year course, the expectation is that you will complete the course.
