Gather the following items to bring with you to the credit union:

- * \$10 for the initial deposit into your Share (Savings) Account.
- * State Issued Driver's License or I.D. Card (with up-to-date address)
- * Social Security Card (Tax Return, W2, or Pay Stub showing your SS# may be used in lieu of card)
- * A third form of I.D. (any of the following will be accepted):
 - > Employee I.D. Badge
 - > Military I.D.
 - > Government Issued Passport
 - > VISA or MasterCard showing your name
 - > Utility bill in your name (cell phone bills will not be accepted)

Share (Savings) Account

This is the core account for membership and a \$10 minimum balance is required. Start saving by paying yourself first with payroll deduction.
