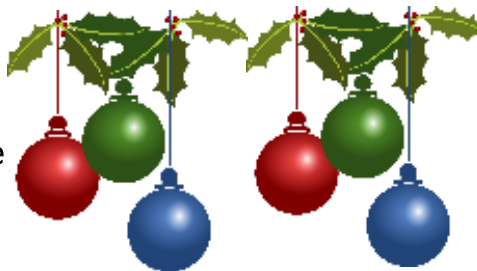

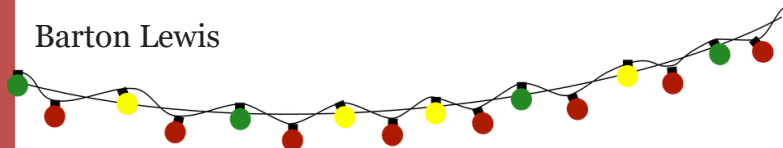
Sunny Heights Families,

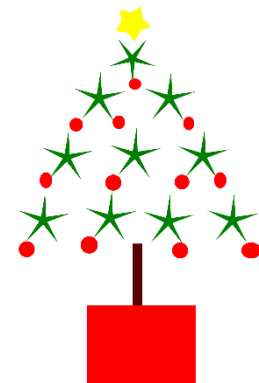
