

STUDENT ABSENCES

When your child is absent, **you must call** the school office at 317-532-2900 by 10:00 a.m. to let us know the type of illness and how long you expect your child to be absent. We also ask that you send a note to school with your child on the day he/she returns. If the school is not notified about the absence, you may receive an automated attendance call and the child's absence will be recorded as unexcused.

BIRTHDAY TREATS

Warren Township School policy emphasizes on academics and fairness to all children, birthday treats and party items are not allowed during school hours. Please do not send food items or party invitations to school. Also, balloons and flowers <u>are not</u> to be delivered to students at school.

BACKGROUND CHECKS

For the safety of our children, a background check must be done on anyone who volunteers at schools or chaperones on field trips. Once a person is approved, the background check is valid for two school years. You can get a form from the school office that needs to be filled out and returned to the school office along with your drivers' license that we will need to copy.
