We are currently using a portion of regrind plastic (from our own defective parts) in our resin wedding chairs manufacturing process. These percentages are as follows:

C440 white 14.6% C450 white 33.0%

Our steel frame is nearly 100% recycled steel. We also offer fabrics made with olefin, a fiber manufactured from postindustrial waste.

Classic Series™ ABS Lightweight Plastic Tables

50% of the ABS plastic used on our ABS tables is regrind material.

End of Product Life

Although all PS products are built to withstand years of demanding use, they will eventually reach the end of their useful lives. We suggest to all of our customers recycling of the products when this time comes.
