Dear Brookview Families,

Here we are...we celebrated the 100th day of school this week with a lot of fabulous learning activities, and we are about to say goodbye to January! Wow! The year is flying past. This is an exciting time of year with a lot of really important things about to happen! As we push into February and March... 1st grade students will be participating in the Cog AT test, then 3rd and 4th grades will roll into ISTEP and 3rd grade will take IREAD.

With all of these important assessments coming up, it is vital that students have the opportunity to engage in every minute of learning from bell to bell. This means that it will be important that every student attends school daily, arrives on time and remains in class until the dismissal bell at the end of the day. Because every minute of learning is important for every student and the safety of our students is paramount, we will no longer be releasing students from class early at the end of the day for pick up unless your child needs to leave early on a given day for an appointment. (If there are extenuating circumstances, I would be happy to meet with individual families to create a workable pick up plan.) I also would like for our school families to know that your thoughts and concerns are very important to us; therefore the changes in pick up procedures are also in response to concerns that have been voiced in regards to parking lot safety. Because of safety concerns, I am requesting that parents remain in the car rider line when possible, rather than entering the building, to minimize the number of children and pedestrians crossing traffic lines in the parking lot at dismissal. If you feel that it is necessary to come in and sign your child out, please park, visit the front office and place your child's name on the pick up list. Students will then be called from the cafeteria once classes have been dismissed.

As always, the safety and learning of our Brookview students is a priority we all share. I appreciate your willingness to help us ensure that all of our students have the opportunity to take advantage of the amazing opportunities happening bell to bell, as well as being a part of keeping all of our students safe at dismissal.

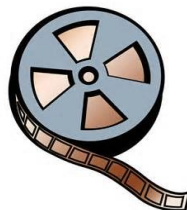
