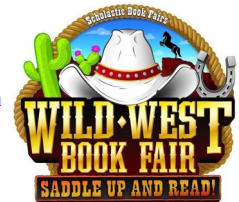

Warren Community Fest

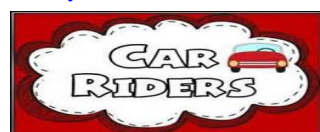
Important
