



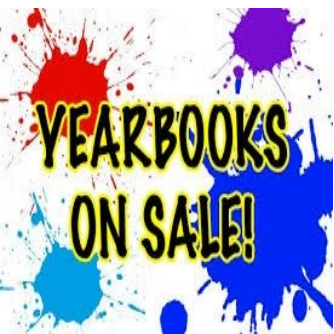

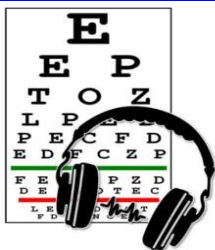

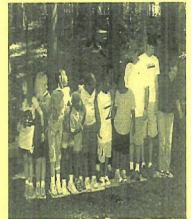

Brookview Night will be May 1st from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

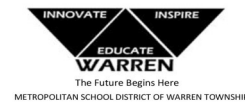
