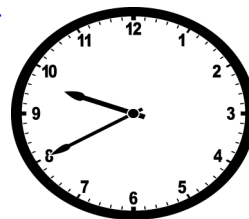

Acceptable shirts/tops:

- ♦ Shirts must cover shoulders, midriffs, and backs. (NO tank tops, spaghetti straps, sundresses, etc.)

Acceptable shorts/skirts

- ♦ Shorts and skirts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.

Acceptable Shoes

- ♦ Toes and heels MUST be covered. (No flip flops or sandals.)

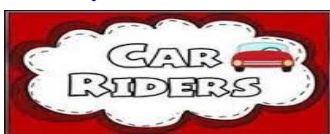
