Warren Community Fest BOOK FAIR IS




Due to unforeseen circumstances Warren Community Fest (including the Fun Run) currently scheduled

DRESS EXPECTATIONS

Just a few reminders concerning dress expectations.

Acceptable shirts/tops:

Shirts must cover shoulders, midriffs, and backs. (NO tank tops, spaghetti straps, sundresses, etc.)



Shorts and skirts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.

Acceptable Shoes:

Sandals are permitted with heel straps. NO flip flops or slides (pool shoes).
