DRESS EXPECTATIONS

Just a few reminders concerning dress expectations as the weather is turning warmer.

Acceptable shirts/tops:

- ◆ Shirts must cover shoulders, midriffs, and backs. (NO tank tops, spaghetti straps, sundresses, etc.)



Acceptable shorts/skirts

- ◆ Shorts and skirts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.



Acceptable Shoes

- ◆ Toes and heels MUST be covered. (No flip flops or sandals.)

If your student's apparel does not meet dress expectations they will call home and different clothes/shoes will need to be brought to school to change.
