IMMUNIZATION EXCLUSION - MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 17th



All families that have a student(s) with NonCompliant Immunizations have been notified by a letter sent home with the student.

Warren Township has set an Exclusion from school date starting on Monday, September 17th. Beginning on September 17th, your child may not return to school until documented proof of immunizations has been provided or has an appointment scheduled. If you have an appointment scheduled, please notify the Nurse with the date, if you have not already done so. Please call Nurse Jessica with questions at 317-532-3055. Records may be faxed to 317-532-3089.

ATTENDANCE UPDATE: Regular attendance, starting as early as preschool, is essential to long-term academic success. Nationally, an estimated 5 million to 7.5 million students are at risk academically each year because they are chronically absent—missing 10 percent or more of school days with excused and unexcused absences.

At Brookview, let's intentionally work to improve our attendance rate to 97% daily! We love our students and want to see them every school day.



Dress Expectations

Just a few reminders concerning dress expectations. Acceptable shirts/tops:

Shirts must cover shoulders, midriffs, and backs. (NO tank tops, spaghetti straps, sundresses, etc.)

Acceptable shorts/skirts

Shorts and skirts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.

Acceptable Shoes

Toes and heels MUST be covered. (No flip flops or sandals.)

If your student's apparel does not meet dress expectations they will call home and different clothes/shoes will need to be brought to school to change.
